Cayden Brown is an award-winning juvenile defender and global speaker.

At just sixteen years old, he was appointed as a Juvenile Defender to Oakland County's 52-1 District Teen Court—working alongside judges and attorneys to divert young people from traditional prosecution and incarceration.

He earned his first formal legal credential from Harvard Law School, where he studied the intersection of race and constitutional law, and is the Founding Director of The Trespass Project—a global team of pro-bono attorneys making legal information accessible to children across the globe.

Cayden's work has taken him to some of the world's most influential stages. He has addressed several world leaders at the United Nations and the U.S. Department of Justice, presented for Fortune 500 companies like NIKE and Golden State, spoken at TEDx, and recently appeared as a guest lecturer at the Harvard Graduate School of Education.

His work has earned recognition from former U.S. President Joseph Biden and recent nomination for the International Children's Peace Prize. He has been featured in Forbes and TIME, and is called by ABC "the world's most influential juvenile justice advocate."
